Simple. Achievable. Member-Driven.



CHAPTERS NEEDED

30 chapters in good standing



STATES REQUIRED

10 states



QUORUM

150



Purpose: Allow a significant number of chapters from multiple states to ensure an issue is important enough to consider.



TOTAL KEY REQUIREMENTS: 3

*Straightforward to understand.
Achievable through broad grassroots support.*

PROPOSED LANGUAGE

Complex. Difficult. Greatly Restrictive.



CHAPTERS NEEDED

~400 15% of all chapters in good standing (as of 1/1/26, 15% = 400)

DELEGATE DISTRIBUTION

Delegates must be from at least 20 different states

QUORUM

300 equal to Continental Congress Quorum

TOTAL KEY REQUIREMENTS: 7

*Multiple layers of complexity.
High barriers at every step.*



THE IMPACT:

This proposal substantially raises the barriers to calling a Special Meeting. It replaces a straightforward member-driven process with a more complex national coordination requirement.
