

A VOTE FOR THE RESOLUTION



- Defines a woman as a biological female at birth.



- Restores the Society to the original intent of the Founders as **defined in 1890** as a women's-only organization.



- Affirms that men are encouraged to participate in male lineage organizations such as the Sons of the American Revolution.



- Does not jeopardize the Society's tax-exempt status.



- Returns the authority to define membership to the members of the Society through the bylaw process.

RESTORATION RESOLUTION

Protect Our Name.



The Founding Daughters established this Society as an organization for women. Any change to the definition of membership requires a bylaw amendment approved by the members — not a reinterpretation by leadership.

A VOTE AGAINST THE RESOLUTION



- Leaves the definition of "woman" open to interpretation.



- Prevents the Society from publicly and clearly affirming itself as a women's-only organization.



- Allows for a double standard — accepting amended birth certificates for men, while disallowing them for adopted daughters.



- Continues the use of interpretation rather than formal bylaw amendments to redefine membership qualifications.



- Allows ongoing confusion and misinformation among members regarding eligibility standards.

This resolution does not promote discrimination against women. It restores the organization as it was originally established and preserves the authority of the membership to determine the Society's governing rules.
